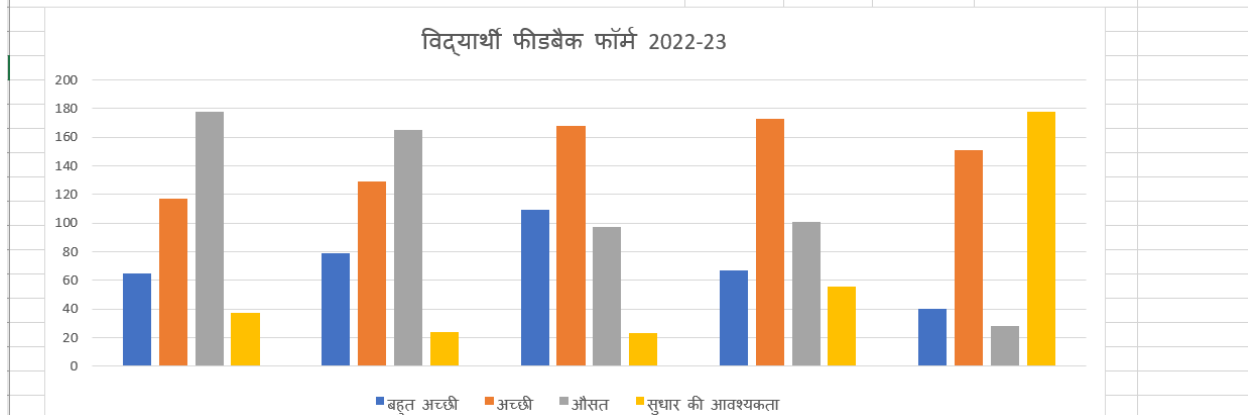

5. Availability of Additional Resources:

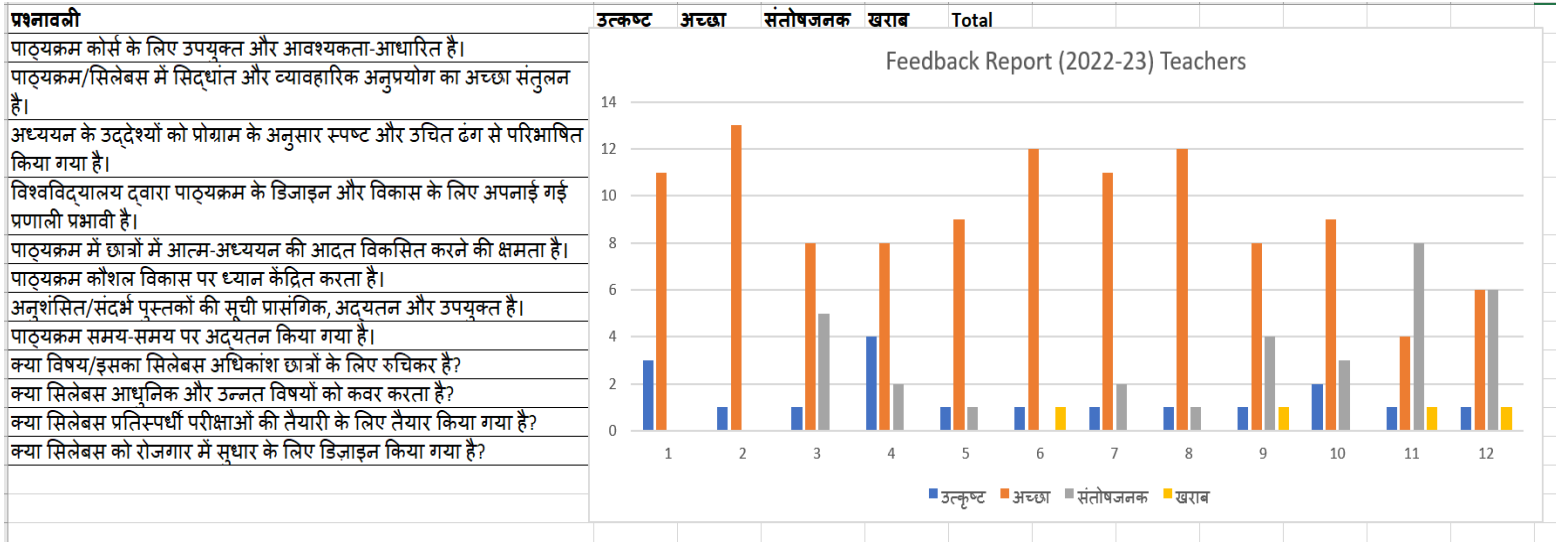
- The availability of supplementary study resources such as books, online classes, and laboratories received diverse feedback. While some students appreciated the resources, others suggested substantial room for improvement.

7. Career-Oriented Syllabus Design:

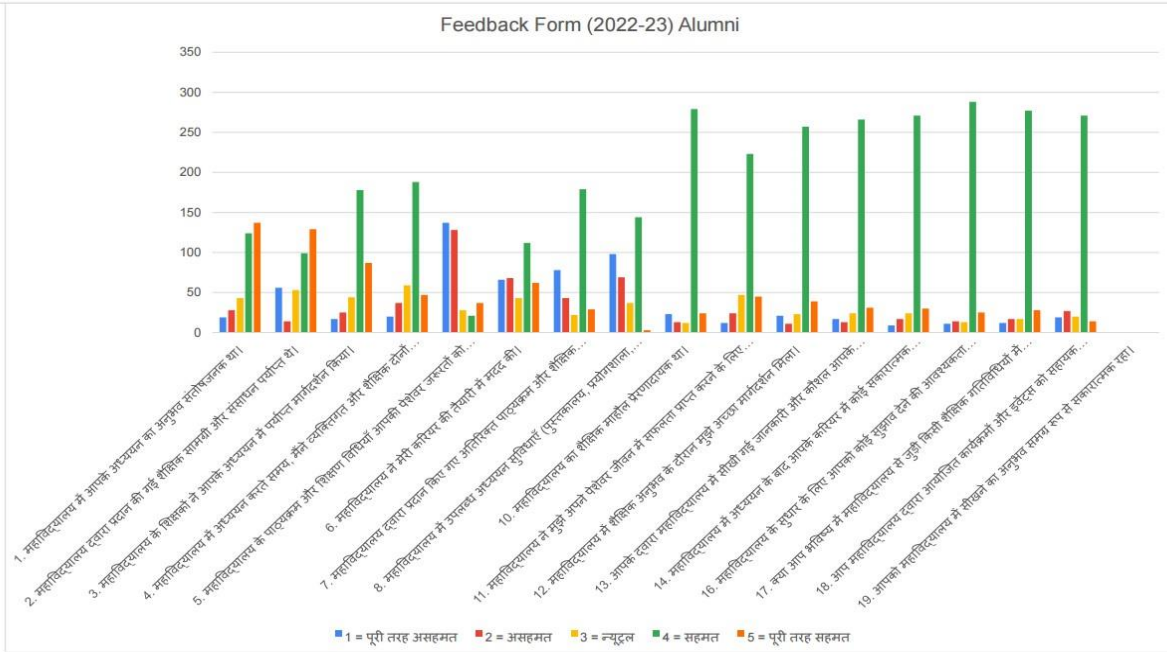
- The curriculum's relevance to employability was positively noted, with suggestions for enhanced focus on career readiness.

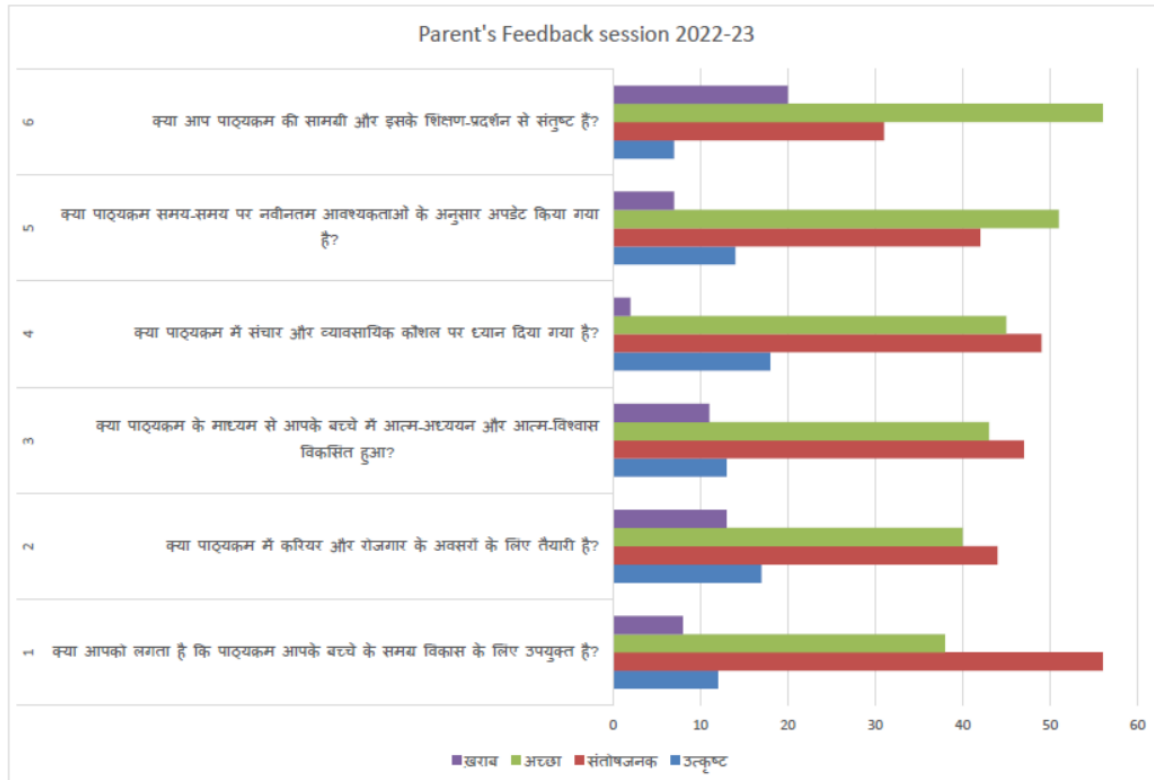


Recommendations:
