- Incinerators: Some colleges and schools in India have installed small-scale incinerators for



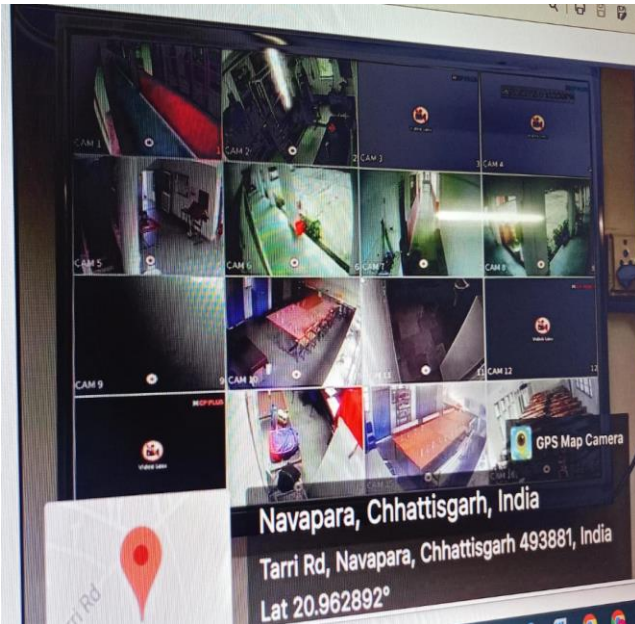
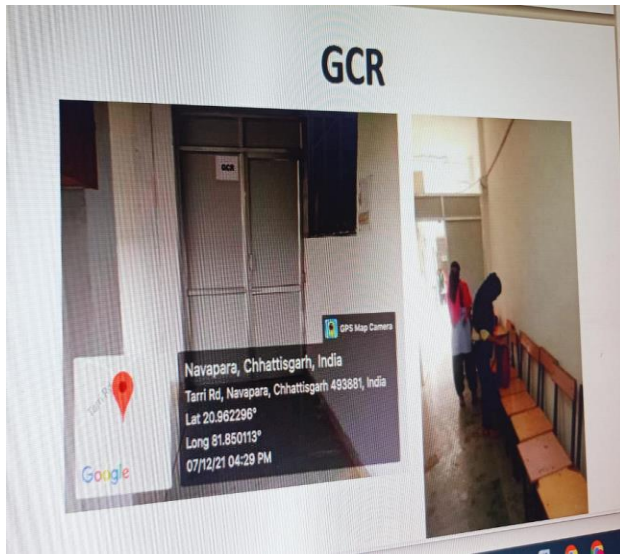
- Proper management: colleges should ensure that there are proper dumping areas for sanitary waste.
